How can I make the most of Year 4?

- Follow the school values and behaviour expectations:

- There will be some bigger projects over the course of the year




PE

- > 2 PE lessons a week
- PE lesson I: MONDAY
- PE lesson 2: FRIDAY
- PE to be worn to school on a PE day.
- It must be clearly labelled to include a white t-shirt, shorts or jogging bottoms, trainers/suitable PE footwear (NOT school shoes) and a jumper for outdoor games.
- Ensure no jewellery is worn on P.E. days and that long hair is tied back.



Spellings



- Taught at the beginning of the week
- Practised in school
- Please practise and discuss at home so they understand the patterns and rules
- ▶ Tested at the end of the week through a dictation test which contains the spelling words
- The children are expected to use these words in their work

Reading

- ► Children will have 10-15 minutes daily individual reading time.
- ▶ It is still important for your child to practise reading aloud at home.



- Any comments should be recorded in their reading diary when children read at home-the expectation is a minimum of 3 times a week.
- ▶ Karate reading bands will be given out for every 25 <u>home</u> reads.
- > Your child will be heard reading by an adult at least once every 2 weeks.
- Children will be given an Accelerated Reader levelled book. It needs to be brought into school every day. Children will quiz on the book before changing it.
- Children will have 4 reading lessons a week in class.

Karate Readers

- Karate readers encourages children to read more at home.
- One read per day.
- When a child has read at least 25 times at home they will receive a white wristband.
- For a 'read at home' to count there must be a signature from an adult in their reading book.

There are many different colour wristbands to earn:

25 reads - white band

■ 50 reads - yellow band

■ 75 reads - orange band

■ 100 reads - green band

125 reads - blue band

150 reads - brown band

175 reads - black band

200 reads - white band PLUS

Curriculum


