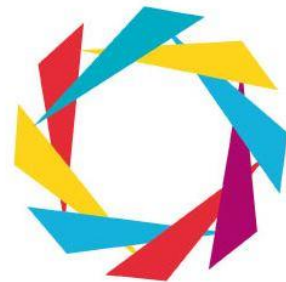

SATS WEEK

- Spelling paper

- Optional SATs Club will start nearer the time

READING

- One of the most important things that can be done in preparation for SATs.
- Karate bands for every 25 reads at home. Children can fill in if parents/guardians tick or sign.
- Accelerated Reader book (Complete a diagnostic assessment which will give children a level. They will move up a level when they have passed a quiz.)
- Reading for pleasure - Book can come from the library.

WORK AT HOME

- Weekly spelling tests
- Aim to read 3+ times a week (Karate Reading)
- Weekly homework revising from the week (Maths and English)
- Times Table Rockstars
- CGP and other SATs revision books
